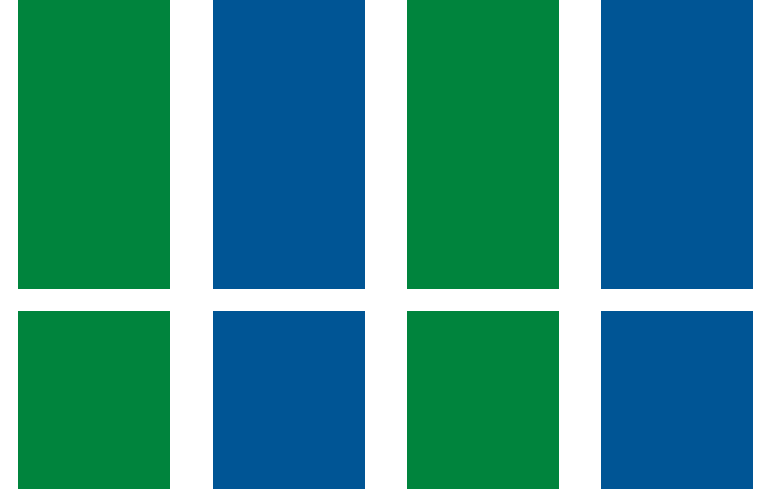

Aqualia Receives the Workplace Equality Award

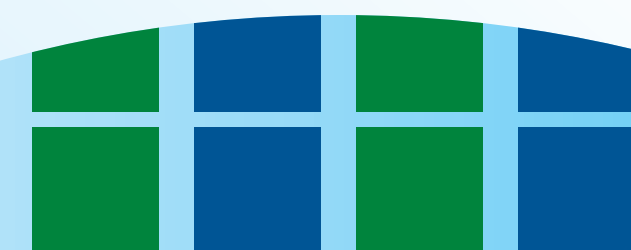
